Oracle BigMachines Yellow Belt provides learners with the basic skills and knowledge necessary to administer an Oracle BigMachines site. Admins will learn how to configure the application to meet simple use cases with both sales users and future administrators in mind. Exercises and demos throughout the course give learners hands on experience in the setup of an Oracle BigMachines site for an example company that requires common uses of the application. The course begins with an overview of the Oracle BigMachines application, process and general administration topics. After establishing a base for administrating the system, the Yellow Belt covers the three main areas of administration; Configuration, Commerce and the Document Engine. Best practices and design considerations are given for each area of the application. At the end of the course, students will be able to build a basic configurator, customize the pre-installed commerce process and link it to a new Document Engine output.
